Dr. Melburn E. Landin, 90, of Sugar Grove, Pa, passed away on Saturday, February 27, 2021, at the John & Orpha Blair hospice house.

Born on April 30, 1930, in Sugar Grove, a son of the late Arthur and Alice (Lundburg) Landin, Mel grew up in the home that his father built. As a young boy, he became a member of Mission Covenant Church.

Mel received a Bachelor's degree from Alfred University and a Doctorate from Case Western Reserve School of Dentistry. He married the love of his life, Margaret "Peggy" (Berquist) Landin, on August 20, 1955. After teaching Physics at Eisenhower High School for a year, Mel served in the US Air Force as a dentist for a few years.

In 1959, Mel moved with his young family back to his home in Sugar Grove to start his dental practice, was joined by his son, Paul, in 1989, and continued until his retirement in 2001.
